Dear Parents

I do hope that this letter finds you well. I wanted to write to you to confirm our procedures during this rather challenging time and especially now that we are entering the common cold season!

As I know you will understand schools are continuing to do what they can to reduce the risk of COVID-19 spreading. However if pupils do have a cough and/or a high temperature and/or a loss of taste and smell then we will be asking you to get your child tested. If your child has a cold but none of the symptoms above then of course they can come into school and do not need to be tested.

I am sure you have seen in news (or even experienced firsthand) the extreme difficulty in getting tested currently. Schools have been sent a handful of tests to provide in extreme cases. If you are asked to get your child a test parents will need to try for 2/3 days before approaching the school for options.

We will always inform the bubble if a member is suspected of having the virus and then the outcome of the test. We would be providing more information regarding bubble closures if a test is positive.

Please do continue to keep our school community as safe as possible by maintaining the 2m distance at the busier times. Thank you for your continued support.
