- Flower Fairies can visit until 20th March
- Flower Fairies should only leave their gifts in the clearly marked planters/pots around the playground
- All 'visits' should be from 8.45 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. or after 3.20 p.m. (once the cars have left the playground)
- Tools should not be necessary as all planting areas are ready. Please come to the office if you require a spade.
- If a parent cannot come into school with their child but would like their child to be a Flower Fairy please let us know and either Mrs Dodd or Mrs Bowling will do this with your child when they bring in their plant

All children will be given the opportunity to work in the gardens and help with seeds and growing throughout the school year.
