Dear Parents

I thought I would write to you to confirm the measures we have in place for home learning should we need to close a bubble or if the government decides to schools again.

I know that like us, you are doing all you can to minimise the risk of spreading the virus. So far all tests have been negative. However, if we do need to close a bubble or bubbles (following advice from the Department for Education or the Health Protection Team) we will do the following for remote learning:

- In 24 hours of a bubble closing the class teacher will host a Remote Learning Refresher for all parents via Zoom. We will give you the details for this via email/Studybugs.
- In 48 hours remote learning will be available using Purple Mash, Bug Club and Zoom Guided Reading sessions.
- Pupils who are entitled to Pupil Premium Funding will be provided with a laptop to access remote learning but with the agreement that there is full engagement with remote learning.
- Paper copies of work where requested can be supplied by the school.
- If the government closes all schools parents will be contacted either by phone or email every two weeks. It is expected that if all schools are closed then Key Worker and Vulnerable (Looked After pupils and pupils with an EHCP) will still be able to attend school.

If a pupil is absent from school for 14 days because a family member has the virus, the class teacher will provide home learning and this will be explained via telephone or email.

We understand that tests are now more readily available and this process should be much quicker. The school will not provide home learning whilst pupils are absent waiting for test results. The school will also not provide home learning to pupils who have taken holidays during term time or school holiday time which then require the family to isolate for 14 days.

I know we are all hoping that this won't happen, but please be assured as before we will still be here to support you if it does.
